Dear Band Parent(s) and Guardian(s),

I am pleased to offer your student the opportunity to use a school owned instrument for the 2019-20 school year. Students are asked to pay a once-a-school-year rental fee of \$35. The \$35 will go to help offset the cost of yearly maintenance and repairs. Here are some examples of upkeep and maintenance for each section.

Percussion: Replacing drumheads and mallets, adjustments to mallet instrument's tuning bars, and purchasing instruments for the percussion section.

Brass: Cleaning and flushing the instrument, soldering braces, replacing worn out corks, adjusting keys, and replacing springs.

Woodwinds: Pad and cork replacement, key adjustments, and replacing springs.

If you choose to use a school instrument, the expectation is the instrument will be returned in the condition it was issued in. Damage beyond normal wear (example: dents, bent keys, or stuck keys and slides) will need to be repaired at the student's expense. Repairs need to be completed before the end of the year check-in. Many of the issues listed above can be avoided with proper care of the instrument.
